



Camping Rules

The following rules should make for a memorable and pleasant campers' experience

Tents

- Tents should be set up only **in designated areas**.
- No holes for poles. Tents should have their own supporting structure and stakes (cutting branches will get you off the campground).

Fires

- Fires are permitted only **in designated areas**, should be **attended at all times** and **extinguish** when you leave.

Quiet time

- **Quiet** must be observed between **10 p.m. and 7 a.m.**

Bathrooms

- Bathrooms are found in the Visitor Center and in the Auditorium
- Tap water is not potable.
- Dishes cannot be washed in the bathroom.
- **Leave the bathroom** in as good of condition as you **found it**.

Safety measures

- There are night watchmen on the grounds.
- The Reserve is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- Do not swing or jump on the hanging bridges, you put at risk your safety and that of others.

Wildlife

- **Don't feed the animals**. It can harm them and put you at risk.
- Wild animals are unpredictable. Stay clear and never touch them.
- To see wildlife, remain quiet.
- Stay on the nature trail. Do not cut switchbacks or take shortcuts.

General comments

- People who cause disorders or do not observe these regulations will be expelled from the camp without the right to any refund.
- No pets allowed.

- Place garbage in the bins.
- Please do not cut or tear flowers or plants.
- **No smoking allowed.**

Lakeshore:

- If you want to swim, remember lake water is polluted. Avoid drinking it.
- There is no lifeguard. **Swim at your own risk.**
- The shore has a rocky bottom, be careful not to slip.
- Reeds have been planted as habitat for fish, crabs and birds, don't pull them out.
